POOLS ON THE PARK HEALTH SUITE CLOSURE - COUNCIL DON'T BE MEAN!



The Council's Environment Committee approved a plan to refurbish Pools on the Park's exercise areas but not its Health Suite, essentially on financial grounds. Many residents spoke against this proposal and the controversial decision was opposed by myself and one Liberal Democrat councillor. I don't think the process was transparent and I don't think the benefits in both health and economic terms of keeping the Health Suite were assessed properly. You shouldn't have to be rich to access services that are publicly available in many other boroughs.

Residents across the borough are very worried about the new Thames Water plans to dig up Ham Lands and Moormeads Rec Ground to pipe water from the Thames near Teddington Weir across to north-east London and replace that water with treated effluent from the Mogden treatment plant. The project raises many environmental issues - the government needs to listen to the people and revise its water strategy. Chas joined the recent protest march alongside Green Councillor Andree Frieze and Hackney Green Party prospective parliamentary candidate Antoinette Fernandez - the plan affects Londoners in north and east London too.
